**IN JUNE WE CELEBRATE:**



**Flag Day**, June 14<sup>th</sup>. This day commemorates that day in 1777 when the Continental Congress adopted the Stars and Stripes as our nation's flag. It then had only 13 stars, to match its 13 stripes. It is observed by displaying the flag. It is not an "official" Holiday, but in Pennsylvania it is a legal holiday.



**Father's Day**, June 17<sup>th</sup>. On this day we express our gratitude and appreciation to our Fathers by giving them gifts, sending cards and making or taking dad out for dinner.



**The Summer Solstice** – The First Day of Summer - June 21<sup>st</sup>. On this day in the Northern Hemisphere, the length of daylight is at its maximum. For most people in the Northern Hemisphere, this is the time to just relish the long daylight hours while we can, knowing that beginning the next day the nights will get longer and the fall and winter seasons will come once again.
